LAST-SECOND TD BEATS TIFF

Bulldogs Make Great Comeback, 16-14

You talk and think about the boys coming back in a ball game and tonight they just reached out and got the little something extra it takes."

So spoke Thomasville High head coach Jim Hughes as the Bulldogs' Big Red Offensive Machine recovered from numerous mistakes and pulled across the winning touchdown with just five seconds remaining in the game.

The extra point try by Randall Hatcher gave Hughes and the Bulldogs their first Region AAA victory over while defeating Tift, 16-14.

"It was a great team effort," said Joe Peoples, the Bulldogs' running back who caught the winning touchdown pass.

"WE DON'T have any bulldogs or individuals on this team," said quarterback Daze Landis as he left the office of happy Thomasville coaches.

With 1:16 remaining in the game, Thomasville drove 51 yards in seven plays and scored with four seconds left on the clock. Landis hit Peoples for the touchdown.

From the Bulldogs' 46-yard line Peoples bounded a punt 40 yards to the Tift nine.

Reginald Wilkerson made a key tackle on third down and forced a fumble by the Blue Devils to give the ball.

After a forward pass Thomasville put the ball in play at its own 10 yard stripe.

Lamb hit Kawonik with two quick passes for 10 yards in 11 seconds.

With 10 seconds remaining in the game, Thomasville used the old flea-flicker with Bill Stidels catching a pass from Lamb and pitching off to Adolphus Warren for 11 yards.

At the Tift 21, Lamb dashed 12 yards and with 31 seconds left tossed a quick incomplete

pass to stop the clock.
